


### Member Demographics

Could you cope financially with a change in circumstances, such as a relationship breakdown, unemployment, or sickness?




Compared to this time last year, how is your current financial situation?




31% Worse If you had to pay an unexpected expense equivalent to one month's income, how much would you be able to cover without needing to borrow?




How long would you be able to live off savings if you were to lose your job or regular income?




Over the next year, how do you expect your financial situation to get?





In the past year, how much of an impact have money worries had on your general feeling of wellbeing / mental health?






## Which of these best describes how often you save money





## What is your main reason for saving with BCCU (select your main reason)


